Joseph Smith bracket clock

During autumn 2014, we heard from a collector who had bought a bracket clock made by Joseph Smith. It is a timepiece, with Knibb-type repeat. When a cord is pulled, the last hour is struck, followed by the last quarter (ting tang). It was probably made during the period between 1725 and 1740.
